Michael Jingoian is a noted philanthropist, social activist, and businessman. He grew up in Watertown, Massachusetts, but has spent the last 13 years in Portland, Oregon. He is a distinguished graduate of NYU, Bentley College and Harvard University having completed a CAS in 1993. With a successful track record for running businesses during the 1980s and 1990s, he became recognized as one of the nation's leading "turn-around CEOs" for the successes he had in such companies as MCS, Flynn Systems, Partners Int'l and SNS.

Just after the Dot.com bust of 2001, Jingoian founded AngelVision Technologies. In 2008, Inc. Magazine recognized AngelVision as the 120th fastest growing company in the US and the fastest growing Interactive Media Company. AngelVision has been honored with nearly 100 awards for marketing, innovation and management since 2006, including:

Mr. Jingoian is a pioneer in the field of holistic management, which has been credited with AngelVision's unprecedented growth. In 2009, AngelVision was voted one of the "8 Best Companies to Work for in Oregon" and the company with the third best benefits package in the state. He invests time and energy in representing the interests of entrepreneurs and helping small businesses develop sustainable business practices. In 2006, he was the recipient of the Pinnacle Award for the "Outstanding Mentoring of Fellow Professionals".

Jingoian's passion is educating voters about the urgent need to abolish our nation's destructive two-party system. He believes that "solutions to the nation's worst problems exist, but that these solutions are not in the interests of the Democrats and Republicans who benefit by the status quo and are concerned only with fundraising and re-election. What's worse is that these valid solutions are running out of time."

In 2008, Michael produced a video titled "Kiss Ballot Access Goodbye," identifying ways in which the Democrats and Republicans create ballot access laws to prevent competition and to stay in power. The video was awarded the Telly Award for Best Internet Commercial for Political Issues, the W3 Award for Best Viral Marketing Video for Activism, the prestigious Marcom award for Best Political Web Video and the coveted Ava Award for Best New Media Political Video.

As one of the leading voices fighting for citizen empowerment, Jingoian was a candidate for President of the United States in 2008 to help spread his message of transparency and accountability in government. During that election, his RESET America website was honored by the Library of Congress for inclusion in the National Archives as one of the nation's premiere political websites. Also in that year, Mr. Jingoian was honored with the prestigious 2008 Marcom Award for "Best Political Website Overall." Michael is also the Vice Chairman of the Libertarian Party and a Board Member for "Rock the Debates" and "Free and Equal."
